### Two years of travel with my sketchbook Debbie Mackinnon

WANDER - 'to walk around slowly in a relaxed way or without any clear purpose or direction...' Such a perfect way to travel with a sketchbook. Just being alert to possibilities and never planning ahead as to subject and how it might look, but allowing myself to rely totally on intuition and what might most grab my attention in the moment.

I love drawing and painting outside on location, keeping the process fast and loose. It always leads to new discoveries. If I haven't drawn it, then I haven't properly seen it. The act of recording things I see in my sketchbook, makes later recall and memory of place so vivid and powerful. This exhibition celebrates slow travel with my sketchbooks, in remote parts of Australia and on my European adventures in 2023 and 2024, when we spent time in Italy, Greece and England.

All my wanderings were filled with wonder.



### Wandering in Australia

I spent time drawing in my beautiful local wilderness - The Bouddi National Park and at Kelton Plains on the Monaro, both in NSW; in wild and remote King Island in Bass Strait, and in rural Tasmania. Each place has its own colour palette and character, reflected in my sketchbooks.


'Do you sell your sketchbooks?'

I love to spend time in Umbria out in the olive groves, watching and observing as the leaves shimmer in the breeze and change in an instant from silver to dark green.



I made many concertina books in the Greek islands recording my travels. The elongated unfolding format allows me to explore ideas of how the landscape expands in front of me. I adopt a very experimental approach, often starting in the middle of the book and

allowing the action in the drawings to expand in any direction. Its a very non linear process. These books are not for sale, but I hope you will enjoy seeing them on display in the show, and more in my Wander book.

All the numbered works on paper in this catalogue (1 - 43) were created (or begun) on location and sometimes tweaked further in the studio, using my sketchbooks as reference.

Each piece is A3 (29 x 42 cm/11.7 x 16.5 inches) on quality watercolour or 200 gsm heavy cartridge paper. They are available unframed, an inexpensive way to start or add to an art collection and very easy to ship interstate or worldwide. A high res image can be emailed on request.
